This is based on the above biblical passage from Nehemiah stating "The JOY of the Lord is my strength." Next week we welcome St. Stephen faculty and staff back onto campus to officially begin their journey in JOY this school year. ### **New Family Orientation**

All new families to St. Stephen School are invited to attend New Family Orientation on Wednesday, August 23, 2023 at 6:30 pm in the school gym. It should last about one hour. It is suggested that parents attend the orientation without their children as the information is geared specifically for the adults.

#### Sneak a Peek

On Friday, August 25, 2023, students and families are invited to St. Stephen School from 9 – 11 am to meet & greet their teacher and see their classroom. This is an "open house" style event. Students are NOT required to wear their uniform. Students are encouraged to bring their school supplies to this event to leave in their homerooms. Students and families will begin this event by visiting the St. Stephen School tent (it's red) in the parking lot. Here you will receive your Scavenger Hunt list to complete. ## First Day of School & Early Dismissal

We will begin the 2023/24 school year on Monday, August 28, 2023. A detailed email regarding the arrival and dismissal procedures will be shared next week. All students will wear their regular school uniform, as there will be no special area classes on this first day. Students do NOT need to pack lunch. Kindergarten through grade 8 students will be dismissed at noon. Prek3 and prek4 students will follow the schedule outlined by their child's teacher.

# Early Dismissal: Friday, September 1, 2023

There will be an early dismissal for students and faculty at noon on Friday, September 1, 2023. This means that students will NOT need to pack lunch today. The school office will close after dismissal.

#### No school: Monday, September 4, 2023

Due to Labor Day, there is no school for students and faculty on Monday, September 4, 2023. The school office will be closed.
