As we are halfway through this second full week of Lent, I encourage you to acknowledge your weaknesses and seek the love of God. You have the power to be a role model to your children in how you can choose to continue to build a relationship with the Lord. Thank you to 7th and 2nd grade for leading the school in Stations of the Cross at the end of last week. At the beginning of next week, your child will be bringing home their March Family Prayer Table addition. For this month, you will be receiving Stations of the Cross for your family to use for the remainder of Lent.

Students in grade 5 and 8 will be taking the ACRE (Assessment of Childhood/Youth Religious Education) during the week of March 4. This is an online assessment, required by the Archdiocese, that evaluates the faith knowledge and attitudes of students in Catholic schools with questions related to religious beliefs, attitudes, practices, and perceptions. Even though it does not impact your child's trimester grade, we do ask that you encourage your child to take it seriously as it does provide data for the school as well as for the Archdiocese.
