Students may wear SSS logo clothing that was purchased through the Spirit Wear store, athletic clothing with the SSS logo or the SSS "Jesus" shirts. Students can wear SSS PE sweatpants or pajama pants or sweatpants with the SSS logo/wording. Hats are not permitted on Spirit Wear days. If a student chooses to not participate, he/she must wear their regular Friday uniform. There is no additional charge for participation.

April 22: Warm weather uniform begins

Students will transition to the warm weather uniform (what they wore to start the school year in August). Please take the time now to have your child try on their PE shorts, khaki shorts and skorts to check for appropriate length. New uniform pieces can be purchased at Flynn & O'Hara. Please read the handbook, beginning on page 58, for uniform protocols.

Looking Ahead:

April 25: All grades will wear their SSS PE uniform with sneakers. We will host Tug of War for grades 5–8 at 12:30 pm, but all grade levels will be able to watch. The following rules apply for grades 5–8: No eye black; Gloves are permitted, but no spray for hands or gloves;No cleats – sneakers (like what you wear for PE class) only; No name calling, yelling or belittling; No purposeful release of rope to make other students fall. If you are coming to watch, you must park on the church lot and walk over to the soccer field. After tug of war, all students will enjoy the John Carroll Rock Band performance as a Kick Off to our Glow Run and Field Day Fun!
