I would like to welcome Mrs. Michelle Borowy to St. Stephen School as the grade one instructional aide. Mrs. Borowy comes to us after an extensive volunteer career at St. Michael/St. Clement School, where her five children attended. I would also like to welcome Ms. Mary Jo Bagnall to our aftercare program team. Ms. Mary Jo comes to St. Stephen School after a long career in childcare and education. Ms. Mary Jo began working with Mrs. Sharon Tenaro in aftercare yesterday. I am grateful to both of these professionals for wanting to share their gifts and talents with our students and school.

We have begun practicing our safety and security drills for the school year, which were created by the "I Luv U Guys" standard response protocol program. This program is followed throughout all Archdiocese schools and in a number of Maryland county school systems. We held an EVACUATION drill last week and will be having HOLD drills next week. The purpose of these drills is to build muscle memory in all participants so that if a true emergency ever occurs, all individuals know what to do. Finally, we are coming to the end of our grace period for fidelity to the school handbook. Beginning the week of September 9, we will be giving tardy slips for morning arrival, charging for later pick-ups at dismissal, giving uniform infractions for hair/socks/nails/clothes pieces and issuing homework slips. We ask that you take the necessary steps in your homes to follow the protocols and school procedures that are outlined in the 24/25 handbook.

Income Survey to Receive State of Maryland Grant Money
