#### From the Lunch Room

#### SSS Spirit Wear Day - September 20, 2024

#### Save the Date: September 23, 24, and 26 for MAP Testing in Grades 2-8

All St. Stephen School students in grades 2-8 will be taking the AOB required MAP testing on the above dates from 8:30 -10:00 am. We are seeking to create a culture of attentiveness and excellence by having all students in grades 2-8 participate at the same time. We ask that you do not schedule out of school appointments for your students during these dates/times. More details regarding MAP testing will be sent later in the month.

#### Middle School Service Hours Reminders

For the 2024/25 school year, all students in grade 6, 7 and 8 are required to perform 10 service hours. Service hours can be obtained in a variety of ways, including service to the school, the church and/or the community. If the middle school student is also a member of the National Junior Honor Society, he/she will need to obtain and record an additional 10 hours of service. AMiddle school students will need to complete the required service hours between May 4, 2024 and May 3, 2025 for the 2024/25 school year. Each time service is performed, a new form (via the link below) must be filled out and submitted electronically. Specific to grade 8 students that are enrolled in the Confirmation program for St. Stephen Church, this link IS NOT used for service hours for sacramental preparation.
