From the Health Suite

A friendly reminder that a doctor's note is essential when a student has an injury that requires any activity limitation/restrictions, also when they are cleared to return to normal activities. When a student has an illness or questionable communicable condition or is out for 3 or more days, a doctor's note communicates they may return to school. This protocol is also in our handbook. September 26 for MAP Testing in Grades 2-8

All St. Stephen School students in grades 2-8 will be taking the AOB required MAP testing on the above dates from 8:30 -10:00 am. We are seeking to create a culture of attentiveness and excellence by having all students in grades 2-8 participate at the same time. We ask that you do not schedule out of school appointments for your students during these dates/times. MAP testing is a requirement from the Archdiocese and is given online three times a year. Each test is 44 questions in length and is untimed. There is nothing that your child needs to do to prepare for this other than coming to school with a positive attitude, committing to reading each question, thinking about their response and taking their time. MAP scores will be sent home with your child during the week of October 14 along with a letter to help you understand what the scores mean. For our grade 8 families, these fall MAP scores are included in your child's high school admissions packet.

September 27: Early Dismissal

All students will have an early dismissal at noon. There is no aftercare on this day and students do not need to pack a lunch. This is also Grandparents Day for students in grades 4-8 from 10-11:30 am.
