Students may also add-on Halloween accessories including socks, necklaces, hair bows and hats. No make-up, nail polish or hair dye permitted. #### November 1: Two hour delay

The arrival line will open at 9:40 am and the tardy bell will ring at 10:05 am. We will be attending Mass for All Saints Day. All prek3 and any half-day prek4 students will be picked up at noon on two hour delays.

### November 7: Ravens Add-On Day

Students may wear their SSS PE sweatpants and a Ravens shirt/sweatshirt/jersey with sneakers. No additional accessories. There is no cost for participation.

### November 12: Parent Visitation Day for Kindergarten - Grade 2

Parents in kindergarten-grade 2 are invited to join us for Parent Visitation Day on Tuesday, November 12. Parents are welcome to park on the school or church parking lot beginning at 8:10 am. Visitation will be from 8:20 am until 9:50 am, followed by Mass at 10:00 am. Parents need to report to the gym to check-in prior to being dismissed to classrooms. The link to register will be released on November 3.

**November 14:** Early dismissal and Grandparents Day for prek3 through grade 3 students Grandparents Day will be held from 10:00-11:30 am for students in prek3 through grade 3. A registration link will be sent via email on November 1. All students will have an early dismissal at noon. A reminder that there is no after-care on early dismissal days.

### November 15: Asynchronous Student Work Day

In an effort to support teachers at the end of a trimester with grading and report cards in Powerschool, the Archdiocese has instituted an asynchronous work day for students from home on November 15. This coincides with the last day of the first trimester. Students will not be present in the school building on November 15, but instead will work from home on simple assignments that will be provided by their teachers. There will be no live Zoom or Google Meet sessions for students. Students will receive their list of assignments on Thursday, November 14 and the assignments will be graded as part of the second trimester.

**November 18:** Start of the second trimester of the 24/25 school year and Scholastic Book Fair begins. This is also a SSS SpiritWear Day.
