Students in grades 2-8 will be bringing home today their fall MAP scores along with an accompanying letter that explains the Family Report. We hope you find this information useful. If you are still interested in signing up for Parent/Teacher conferences next week, please see the links at the bottom of this email. We ask that you sign up for only one slot when meeting with a teacher. If a teacher's schedule is full, please email them to set up a time during the school day for a phone call conference.

Next week we will be meeting with our Saint teams for the month of October. On Tuesday, October 22, 202, kindergarten through grade 8 students can wear their SSS PE sweatpants along with a shirt/sweatshirt that matches the color of their Saint team. No additional accessories are permitted, other than the Saint team color bracelet that students received in September.
