I wanted to share what a joyful week we have had so far during this second week of Advent. In addition to celebrating the Holy day Mass of the Feast of the Immaculate Conception on Monday, we were able to offer the Sacrament of Reconciliation to students in grades 3-8 on Tuesday. Tomorrow (Thursday) students in kindergarten through grade 8 will participate in Eucharistic Adoration with Fr. Jude in the church.
