Thank you to our families that shared their feedback for the updates to our school uniform earlier this school year. Flynn & O'Hara remains our required uniform supplier and have made changes to their system that mimic the feedback from the parent surveys. There will be a two year grace period for all students in kindergarten through grade 8 to align with the uniform policies and pieces. While we will continue to have a spring and summer used uniform sale, you may notice that all of the "old " pieces will not be available. Remember that there is a used uniform sale this Sunday, March 2 from 10 am until 2 pm in the school gym.
