A special thank you to the veterans that were able to attend our prayer service yesterday. We appreciate you spending part of your day with us so that we could honor your commitment to your country and your faith.

Your child is coming home TODAY with their work for the Archdiocese Asynchronous Day on Friday, November 14, 2025. Hearing & Vision Screening

Baltimore County Department of Health will be present on Monday (11/17) & Tuesday (11/18) for a hearing and vision screening. They will be screening grades PreK-4, 1st, 4th, 8th, and any Kindergarteners that were not previously screened in PreK. They will also screen any student referred with a suspected problem that is not already under medical care. Teachers will send home a consent form to be filled out and returned prior to Wednesday (11/12). If your child does not turn in a permission slip, they will not be screened. After the screening, a written report will be mailed to your home informing you of your child's test results *only if a problem is identified*. No report will be sent if your child passes.
